VPAS provides adults 60 years and older with the resources and opportunities they need to lead engaged lives.

We serve older adults in five counties and the cities within: Augusta, Bath, Highland, Rockbridge, and Rockingham. In FY 2024-2025, we served **8,705** people.



Mind and Body

We provided **5,114** hours of health classes, confident aging education, and senior recreation, and **129,130** healthy meals.



Medicare Consultation

Our certified counselors served **1,251** older adults and individuals living with disabilities.

Transportation

We provided **7,468** safe, one-way van rides to medical appointments, grocery stores, banks, and other life-necessary destinations.
