

Transportation Options Card

Below is a listing of transportation service providers who may assist you with getting to your doctor's appointment.

Check to see if family/friend can provide a ride. If not, please explore the options below.

Transportation Navigator (540-383-6855)

VPAS can help you understand what options are available and assist with scheduling a ride to your medical appointment.

Harrisonburg Transit (540-432-0492)

Harrisonburg City Public Transportation

- * \$1 round trip, age 62+ \$.50 one way
- * Riders need exact change

Harrisonburg Paratransit (540-432-0492)

Harrisonburg City Public Transportation for persons with disabilities.

- * \$2 per one-way trip
- * Riders need exact change

VPAS Senior Transportation (540-383-6855)

Non-emergency service for adults 60 years of age and over. Completed paperwork required before scheduling rides. Donations are appreciated.

Non-Emergency Medical Transportation may be available to those with Fee-For-Service (FFS) Medicaid, Managed Care Organization (MCO), or Commonwealth Coordinated Care Plus (CCC+). Check insurance information for details.

Care Advantage Discharge Express

(540-213-7770)

- * \$69 includes pick up from point of discharge, prescription pickup and other services to get you settled for up to 3 hours immediately after discharge.

Cardinal Care (540-746-1899)

- * Cost based on distance and services requested

American Cancer Society: Road to Recovery (800-227-2345)

- * Prefer at least 3 days notice prior to the appointment.

First Choice (540-437-1997) for medical appointments only and can accommodate wheel chairs and stretchers. Prices vary depending on distance and level of assistance required. Two days notice is required prior to the appointment.

- * Initial fee \$3.50 (ABC & Green) \$3.25(Royal)
- * \$1.80 per mile within the city of Harrisonburg
- * \$2.00 per mile anywhere outside the city of Harrisonburg
- * \$10 minimum when paying with a card
